- The clinician will place the known words for each phoneme on the right side of the table.
 The unknown words for each phoneme will be placed on the left side of the table.
- The clinician will record the results.


1. XX will categorize grammatical structures, articles, nouns, and verbs, with an 80% degree of accuracy rating.

- The clinician will play five separate videos for the client. According to the video, the client will place each word in the correct column creating five subject-verb agreement sentences.

- The clinician will review the client's work once completed and explain, if necessary, any changes that need to be made.
- The clinician will record the results.

2. XX will write five subject-verb agreement sentences when presented with five sets of pictures with a 60% degree of accuracy rating.

- The clinician will start by reviewing the parts of speech.
- The clinician will then explain the difference between the present and present progressive tenses reminding the client that the present tense does not include the "ing".
- The clinician will then present an example picture and sentence. The clinician will ask probing questions about each word's part of speech and then highlight them correspondingly. Red for verbs, yellow for the subject, and black for the articles.

- The clinician will then present the client with a worksheet containing five pictures and five sets of corresponding lines for the client to write.
- The clinician will give the client time to complete their sentences in present tense.
- The clinician will then ask the client to highlight their sentences correspondingly and make corrections as needed.
- Once reviewed, the client will rewrite the edited sentences.
- The clinician will record the results.

- Next, the clinician will provide the client with a worksheet to complete involving three vocab words in a word bank and three definitions.
- The clinician will give the client time to complete the worksheet.

- The clinician will record the results.
- 2. XX will place three vocabulary words in context when presented with a worksheet containing a word bank and fill-in-the-blank sentences with a 67% degree of accuracy rating.

- The clinician will explain to the client what needs to be corrected and together they will make the corrections.
- The clinician will then ask the client to rewrite the sentences with necessary corrections and read the corrected version aloud.
- The clinician will record the results.
